

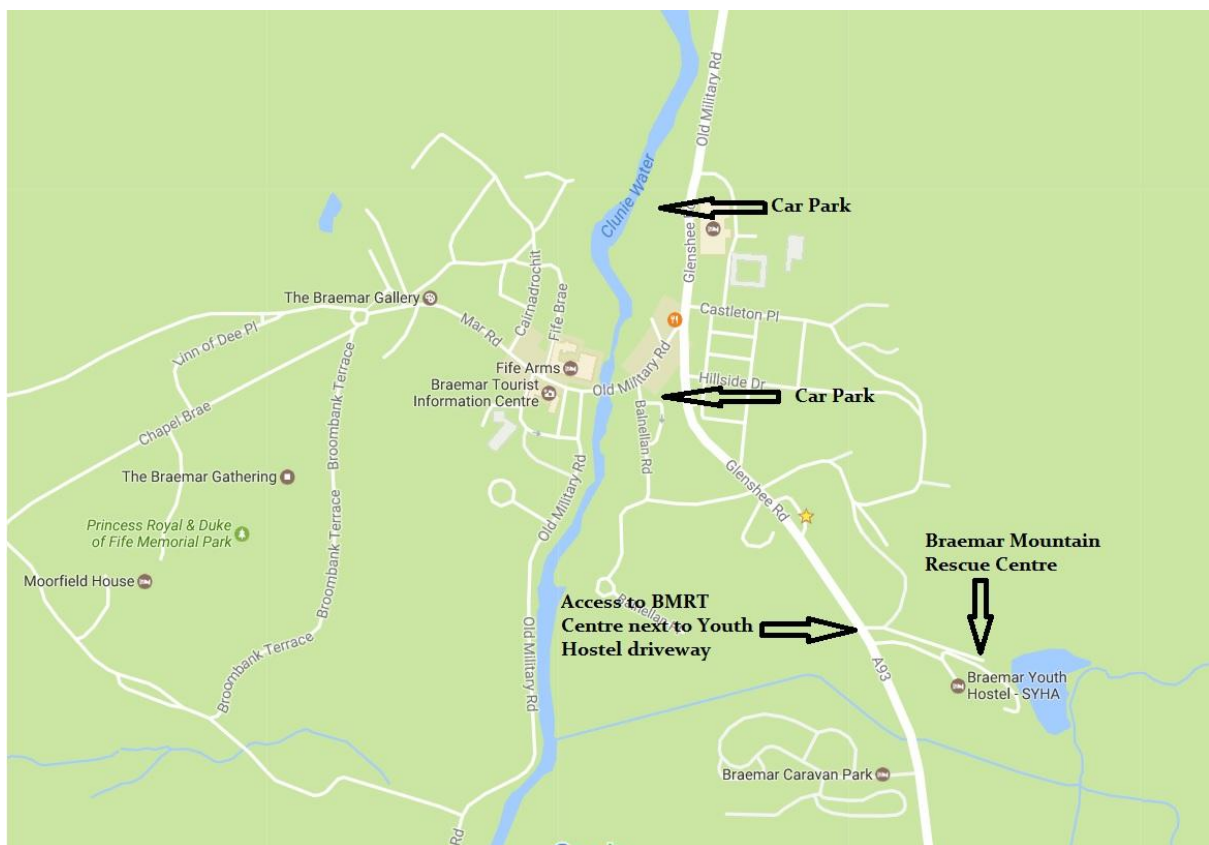
Braemar Mountain Rescue Centre Visit

Sunday 4th March 10am

Braemar Mountain Rescue Team is one of the busier MR teams in Scotland and they cover a diverse and challenging landscape which includes the sub arctic Cairngorm plateau. The unique nature and isolation of many of their incidents has led to the team being at the forefront of vehicle use in mountain rescue. A visit to their rescue centre will not only allow you to view their specialist tracked vehicles but also to learn more about the team of volunteers, the rescues and the way they train.

The visit will last for approximately 1 hour and donations to BMRT are welcomed.

BMRT request that visitors should park in one of the village car parks and then walk to the Rescue Centre, which is located next door to the SYHA hostel on Glenshee Road, as emergency access is required at all times to the Rescue Centre.
